Abstracts of approximately 400 words should be submitted by January 31 to mt.morell@ua.es. Please, also include an additional biographical statement of no more than 100 words, that lists your educational level, current academic affiliation, and any other details you may feel are pertinent.

Applicants can expect to hear back about their proposals by the end of February. Full articles (up to 8,000 words, MLA Style) will be due by June 15. Final articles will be required in October of 2020.

February 28, 2020: Notification sent for inviting full articles (Note that abstract acceptance does not guarantee publication. There will be a regular blind review process for all the manuscripts sent for this special issue)

June 15, 2020: Deadline for submission of full paper.

July 30, 2020: P2P reviews

From October 1 to November 1, 2020: Deadline for submission of final revised papers
